Read this passage of dialogue between Celeste, Demi and Celeste's friend. What do you notice about the text each time someone new speaks?

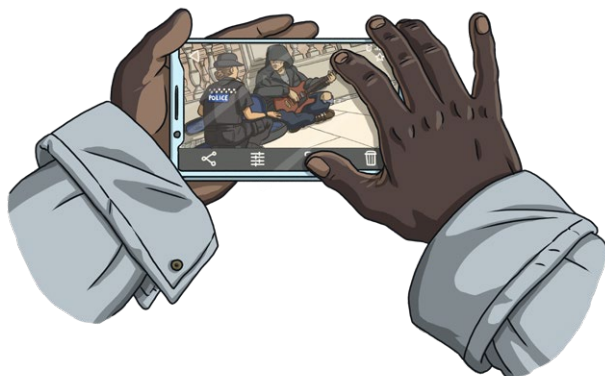
"Is that why you were all here as well?" I ask. She seems much nicer than Celeste.
