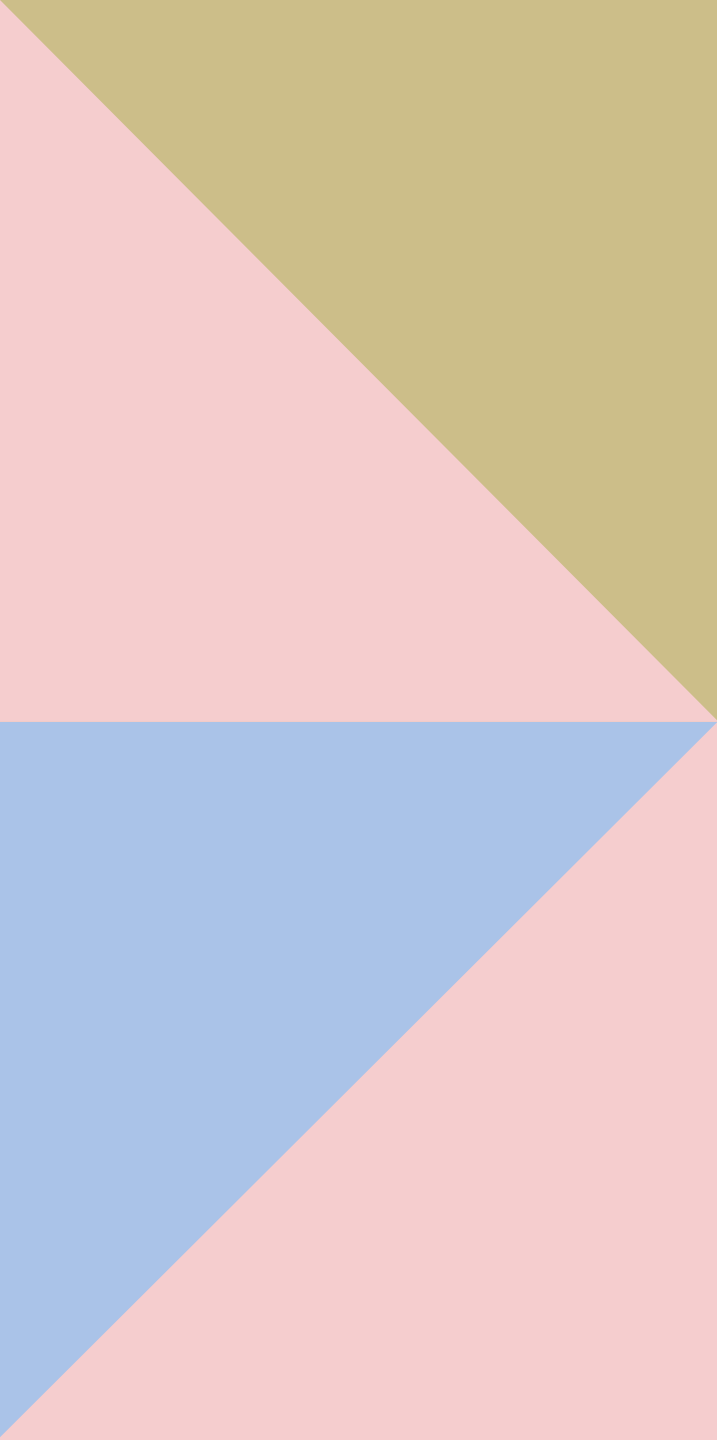

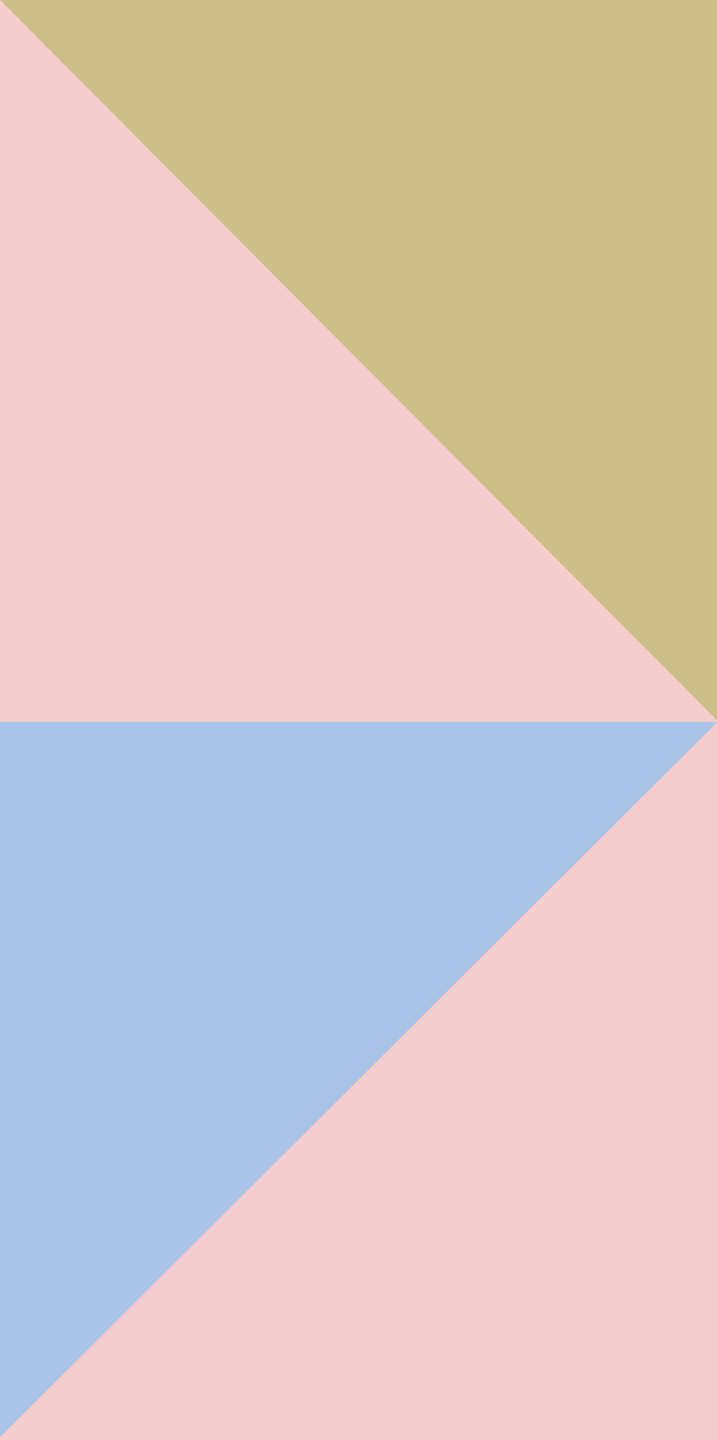
EXPECTATIONS

- Every day children are expected to have:
- Reading records and reading books
- Named water bottle
- Weather appropriate clothing – coats/hats
- A small bag for their belongings.

Please ensure all personal items are clearly named.

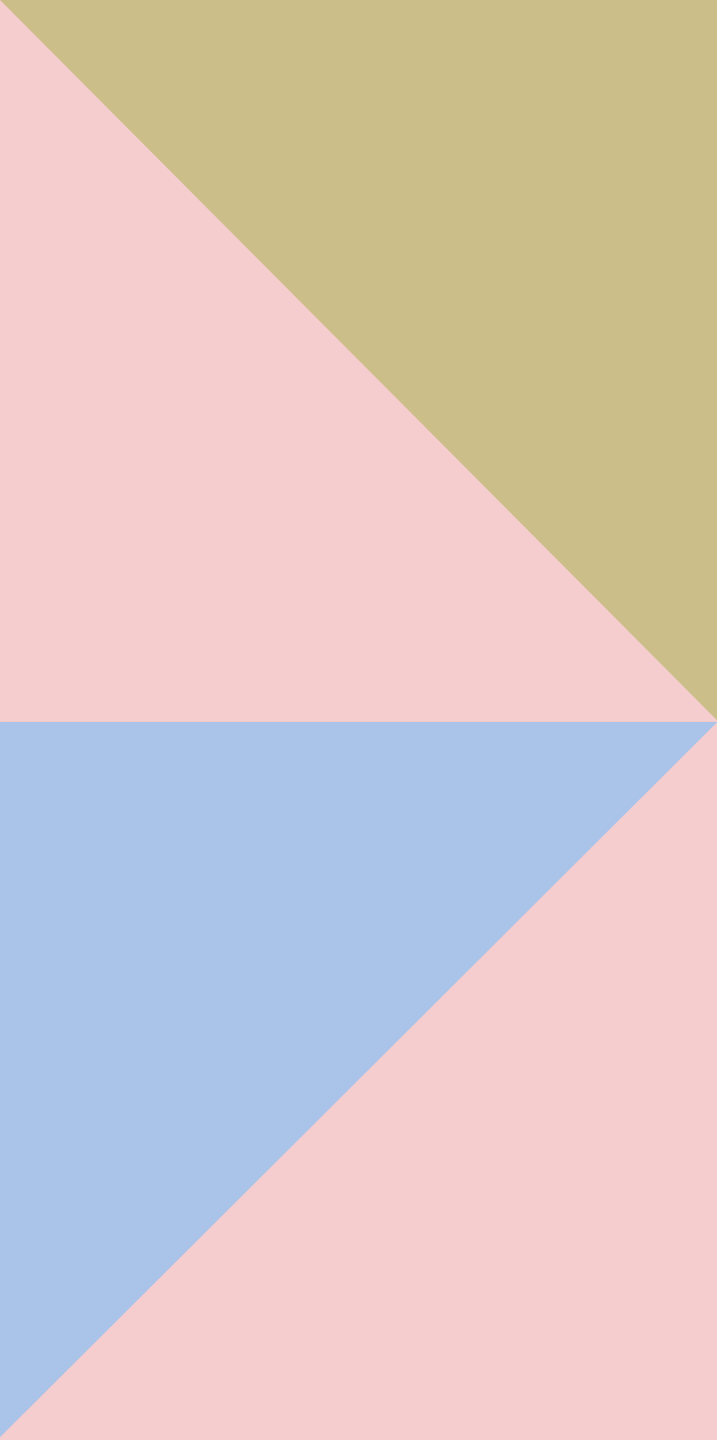
TIMETABLE

- PE will be on Wednesday and Friday – Children are required to wear PE kits to school on these days
- Any sports clubs – PE kits are to be brought into school in a bag and the children will change into these for their clubs
- Generally, English and Maths in the mornings and other subjects in the afternoons
- Gates open at 8.35 and it is important that children are in school as promptly as possible as we start our learning during morning motivation



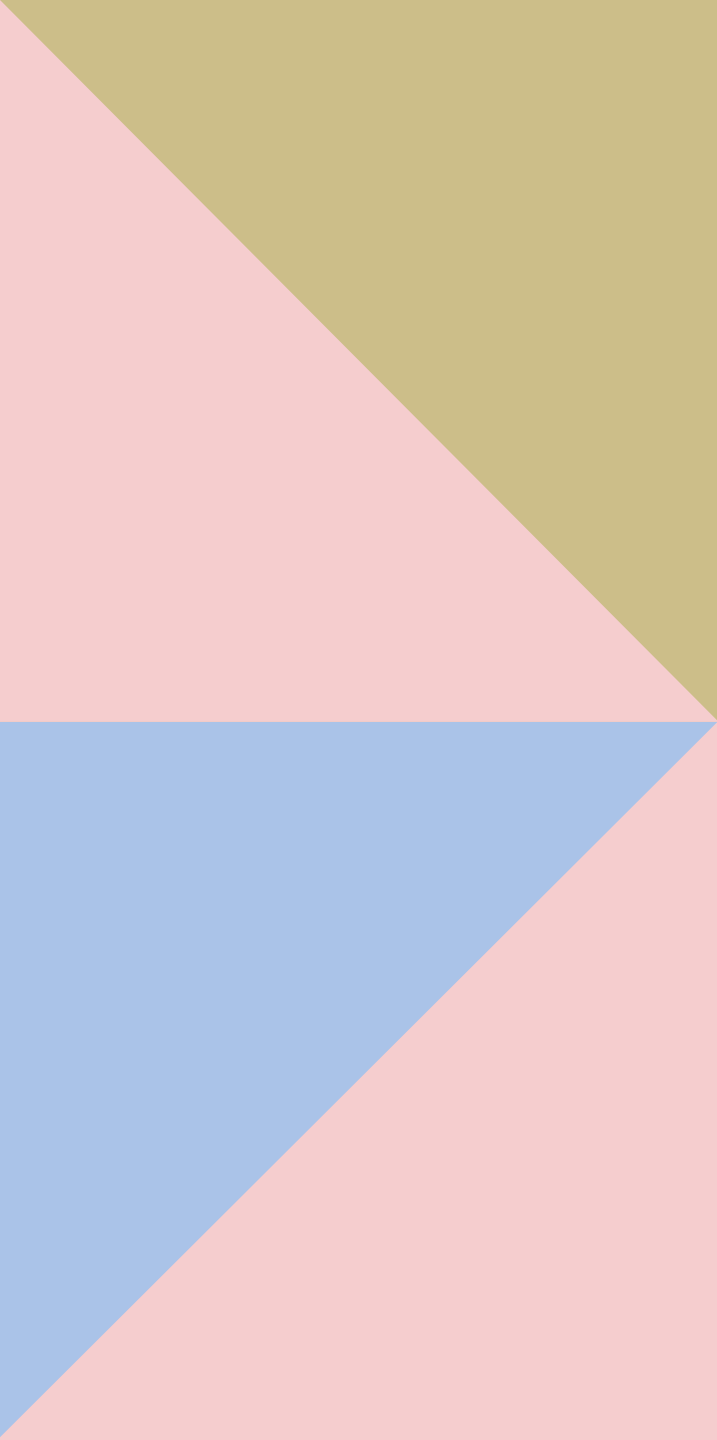
CURRICULUM

- Maths and English every day
- Phonics – Monday to Thursday with Whole Class Reading on Fridays
- History & Geography alternate each half term
- Art & DT alternate each half term
- RE – Judaism and Christianity
- Other subjects are taught weekly
- Trips & visitors – usually 2 – 3 times over the year



READING

- Children should be reading at home daily.
- They will have a reading for pleasure book which is changed approximately once a week, a RWI book and some will have a paper copy of the current book we are using in phonics.
- In school, children participate in 1:1 reading with an adult, so it is important that they have their reading folders in school daily.
- Reading books and records will stay in school on a Tuesday night to be changed.

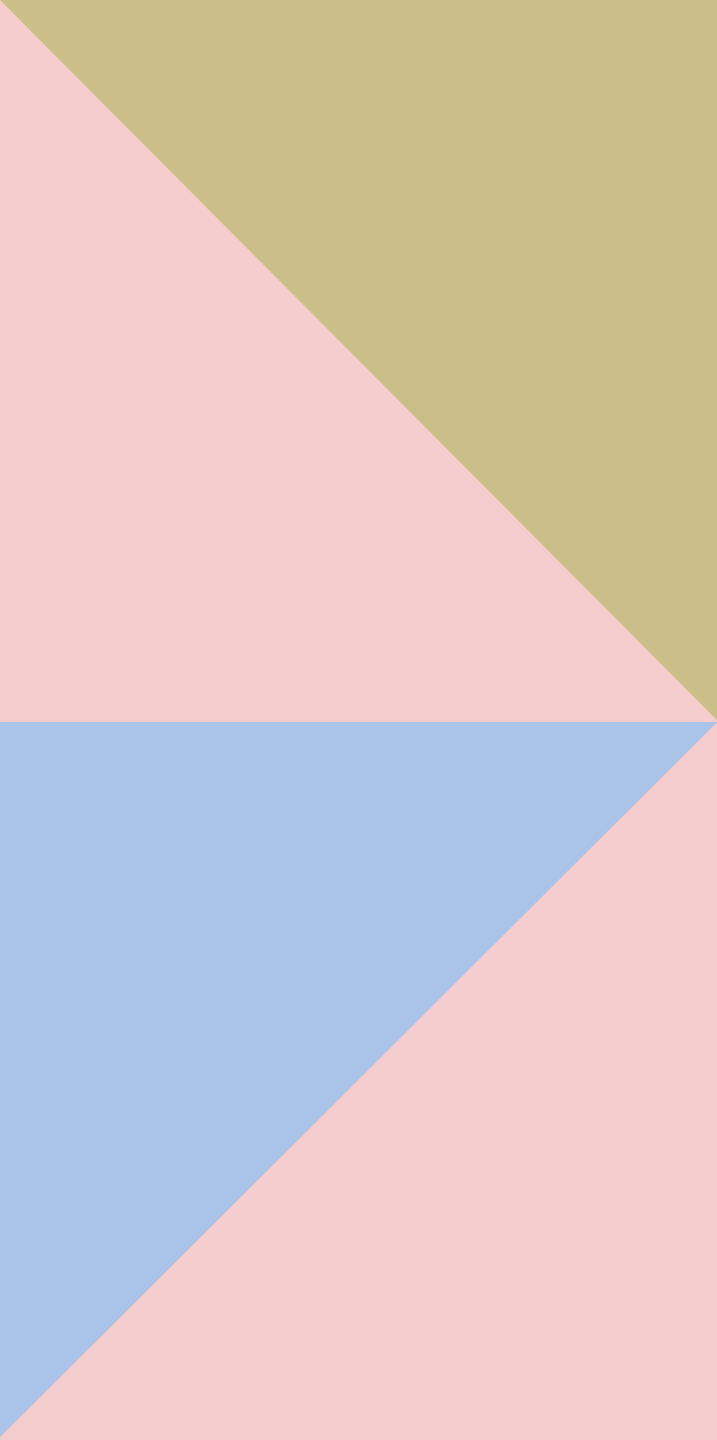


HOMEWORK
