Microsoft Teams

- **Microsoft Teams** is a digital platform allowing teachers to meet with their classes more personally, via 'video conferencing'.
- **Microsoft Teams** is a safe and secure environment that lets teachers communicate with their pupils.

At our school, we will be using Microsoft Teams to allow teachers and pupils to virtually meet on a **weekly basis**, where possible.




Teachers are providing **remote learning** opportunities, as outlined by our Remote Learning Policy.



We expect pupils to follow our **Remote Learning Agreement** [located at the end of the Remote Learning Policy], and to only use the school email address for school purposes.

You will have received your child’s **e-mail address** and **password** via email. This will have been sent to your own email address via the School Office. If you have not received this, please let the Office know.

The e-mail address will provide access to:-

In the first instance, please ensure that you open **Microsoft Outlook** within Office 365 to view your child’s email.

Teachers will have emailed the Microsoft Teams invitations to your child’s email address from **Year Group Account Emails**.

04

Upon opening your child’s email, please **accept** the meeting by clicking on ‘Yes’ or the green tick towards the top right-hand-side of the email.

Please note, children will have to join the meeting from their **school account**.

Two ways to use Microsoft Teams:

1) Web Browser:

2) Teams App: You can download the Teams App to your computer, laptop, tablet or phone. Information about downloading the App can be located here:-

How do I access Microsoft Teams on different devices?



Step 1: Sign in to Microsoft Teams

- 1) In **Windows**, click **Start**, followed by **Microsoft Teams**
- 2) On **Mac**, go to the **Applications** folder and click on **Microsoft Teams**
- 3) On a **mobile device**, tap the **Teams** icon, once you have downloaded this from your device's App Store.



Step 2: Sign in with your pupil's email address and password

Joining a Teams meeting from the App (Recommended)



From your Calendar on Microsoft Teams, select **Join** on a meeting before it's started or one that's in progress.



Turn on your **camera**.



Choose your **audio** settings.



Select **Join Now**.

If you wish to continue with the web browser, click '**Continue on this browser**'.



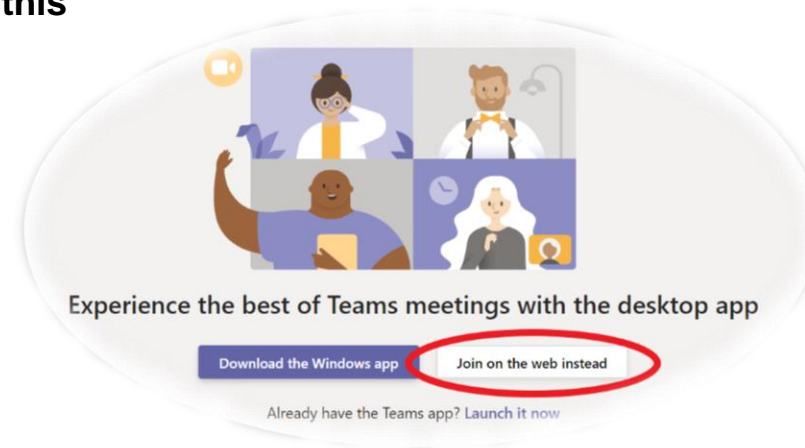
