Family Friends provide short term support to families who are facing difficult times and enable them to get back on their feet. Our help is free, confidential and open to any family living in the Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead with a child aged 0—13 years and up to 18 years for Armed Service Families.

Family Friends in Windsor and Maidenhead have been chosen for the customer vote for a Bags of Help grant from Tesco. It is a scheme which gives community projects like ours grants of up to £4,000 – all raised from the sale of carrier bags in Tesco stores. We have applied for funds to offer 1:1 support to local children with difficulties they are having, such as low self-esteem, loss or bereavement, parental separation, managing changes etc. The public can now vote in Tesco stores in Windsor, Datchet, Langley and Slough, during March and April on who should receive the awards.
