The Christmas Fayre is a really important event for the PTA's fundraising calendar and we rely heavily on the support of the parents and local community to make the event a huge financial success.





These will make fabulous presents for a loved one, or even just for you!


Please start to bring in your donations to the school now and until Friday 26th November and either put them in the labeled box in the office or leave them with Mrs. Leatherby at drop off.





