Thank you to everyone who supported this fundraising event.

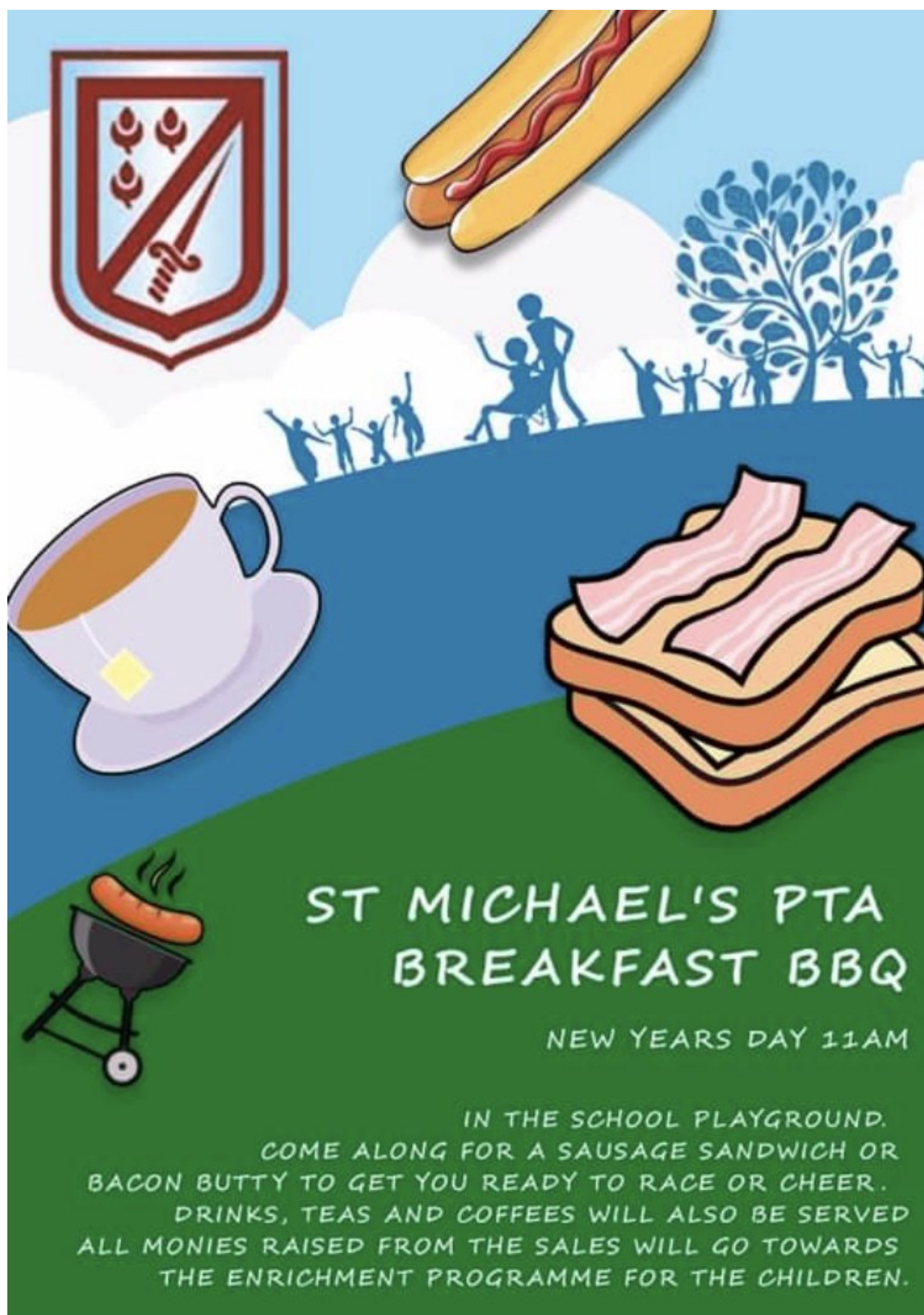
