Dear Parents, Carers,

Spring is definitely on the way!

The weather has been kind to us this week and the children have all enjoyed break times and PE lessons outside, warmed by sunshine. Let's hope this fine spell holds for the PTA Easter Egg Hunt, in the last week of term. All children will take part. The PTA are asking for a voluntary donation of £3 to cover the cost of this much awaited event.

#### Can you help?

I feel it is fair to say that we have all been affected in some way during this pandemic; some, in our community, have experienced changes in employment and a loss in income. The future is looking promising and we all have high hopes for a return to life pre-Covid times, economic growth and financial stability.

Unfortunately, there are families in Sunninghill and in our school community whose lives and livelihoods have been affected by the pandemic. Since the first lockdown in March 2020, due to the generosity of the village and local church communities, we have been able to discreetly help some of our families at St Michael's, with regular supplies of fresh fruit, vegetables, dried goods and dairy products, during this financially challenging time.

Mrs Elaine Finch, through her association with local charities, such as the Hope Trust, has been working closely with the school for many years to support local families in need of pastoral and financial help. In May 2020, Elaine pioneered the provision of weekly, nutritious food hampers, to our school families. Elaine is best placed to explain the rationale and vision behind her work.

I am a Trustee of a local charity that at Christmas helps those in our Parish who are in financial need. Our Parish State schools have been an important part of helping us to identify some of those families who are struggling. This can include those on low incomes but who fail to qualify for free school meals or any other assistance. Being involved with the charity and local State schools has formed my thinking.

My idea, which is completely independent of the aforementioned charity, is to work with the schools in our Parish to identify those children whose families are struggling and to discreetly offer help. The aim is to try and ensure these children get fresh and nutritious food by giving the family a weekly delivery until their personal difficulties improve.

The first school I have started working with is St Michaels in Sunninghill. The Head Teacher, Lorna Anderton, welcomed my idea, which is very much in line with her thinking. We are working together to help some of their most needy families. We began at the end of May 2020. The budget is £20-25 per family per week, which provides 250gms butter, 550gms cheddar cheese, a dozen eggs and a box of good quality fresh fruit and vegetables. This can be increased for larger families or adapted for food allergies or intolerances. The response has been rewarding and, at times, deeply moving.

So, to that end I am raising money to finance the initiative. **Obviously security of income is important and monthly donations by standing order give us this**. However, this commitment does not suit everyone and **one off donations** are most welcome too! **All monies are held in an account specially set up for the purpose and are open to scrutiny.** We intend in due course to get charity status.

NB: Recently the banks have bought in a new verification system but at the moment TSB is not a member, so depending on which bank you are sending money from you may be told that our above account cannot be verified. I am assured by the banks, that as long as you enter the correct Sort Code and Acc. No, [and they are printed correctly here] the funds will get to us safely. I always acknowledge safe receipt of fund. This does not happen with every Standing Order that is set up, and hopefully the situation will be resolved shortly.

If you feel you may be able to support our school community, please contact Elaine Finch directly. We are in this together. We all have a vested interest in ensuring every child and their family feel supported, valued and are able to flourish.
