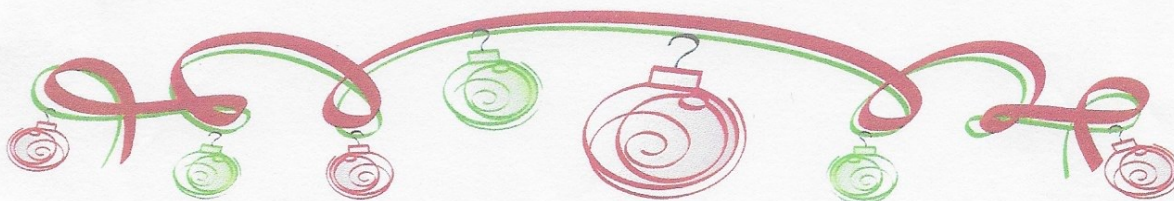

These will make fabulous presents for a loved one, or even just for you!

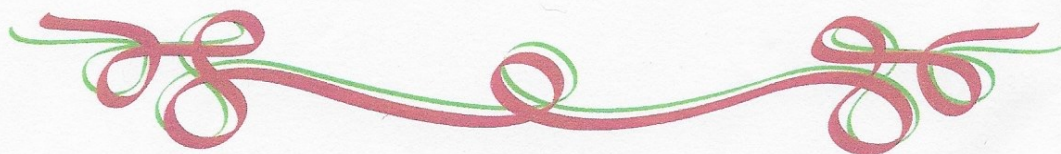
Please start to bring in your donations to the school now and until Friday 26th November and either put them in the labeled box in the office or leave them with Mrs. Leatherby at drop off.
