The estimated total raised is £1200!

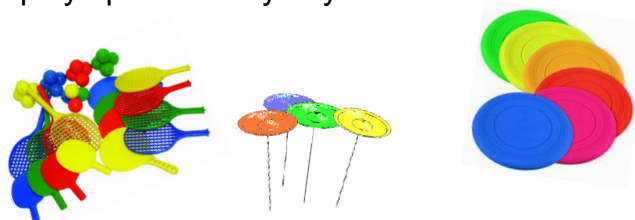
