Wrap Around Care at St Michael's

Magpies, in partnership with the school, are committed to providing quality before and after school care. The after school clubs, from 3.15 - 4.15pm, have proved extremely popular; some have waiting lists and we are continually adding new choices. Cozy-Club is particularly well attended and provides the perfect mix of fun and relaxation to end a busy school day!

We have listened to feedback from parents regarding the cost and extent of care currently offered, and we have decided to run the after school care from 3.15 to 5pm. To show our commitment, the school and Magpies, are offering a free 3 week taster session from 4.15 to 5pm, from October 30th to November 17th 2017. Places are limited and bookings can be made on line as usual, on a first come first served basis. Thereafter, the rate, including a cold healthy tea, will be £5. Please speak to Mrs Leatherby for further information.

Breakfast Club runs from 7.30am until 8.40am. The children enjoy a healthy breakfast with their Magpie coach and friends. We offer a selection of cereal, fruit and toast or crumpets, followed by quiet reading, board games or an activity outside. All at a cost of £6 per day. There is a discount for more than one child. Come and join us, it's a great way to start the school day.

Pobble Relaunch Day for Year 3


