How do we remember this long list of classifications?

A good way to remember lists is to make up a sentence using the first letters in a list. In this case we want to remember **D**omain, **K**ingdom, **P**hylum, **C**lass, **O**rders, **S**uborder, **F**amily, **G**enus, and **S**pecies:
