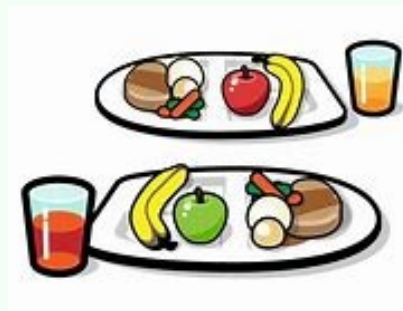

SPORTS NEWS

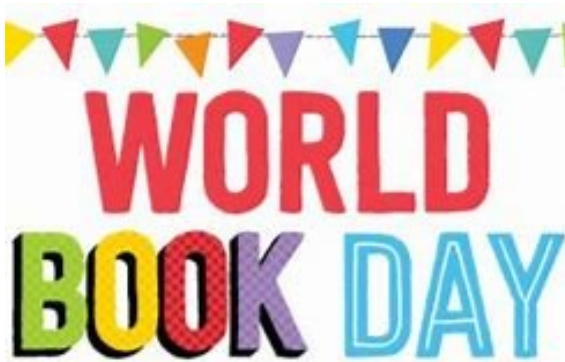

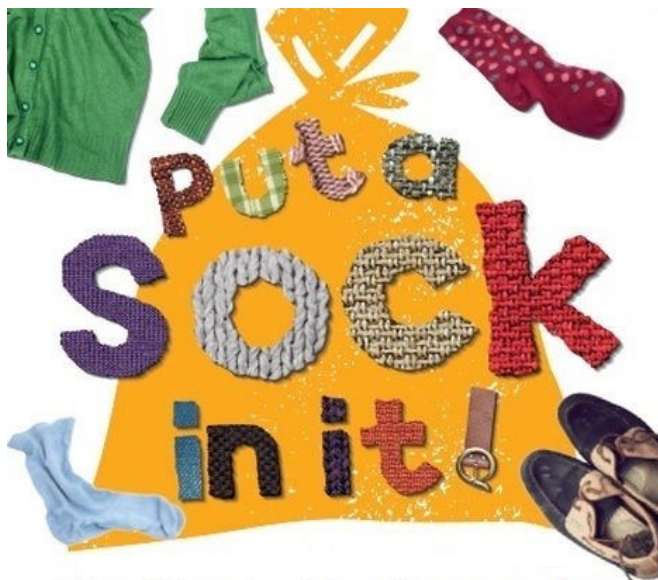
