### St Michael's is in Bloom!

You may have noticed a number of new planters appearing around our playground over this year. As part of our science curriculum, all children are involved in planting and growing their own plants. Year 3 have grown and eaten radishes. Reception, Year 1 and 2 have planted bulbs, tomatoes and sunflowers. Year 6 have planted their forest for the future. Year 4 will be growing cress and Year 5 have planted a range of flowers and vegetables.

We have been working on increasing the biodiversity in our school grounds. Gardening club used the money raised from our plant sale to choose flowers which pollinators (especially bees) would be attracted too. They looked online and kept to their budget to choose their plants. On Friday, the whole Year 5 class were involved in filling the planter Mr Smith made for us, using left-over wood from our wonderful Woodpecker gazebo. We have also continued to fill the beds around Woodpecker classroom. If you have any spare bedding plants or herbs, we will happily give them a home!

Following a request from a younger child, Year 5 have also redone one of the planters in the shade. We will be thinking about plants that might grow well in there.


