Spelling Rule

Words ending in –able and –ible

Words ending in –ably and –ibly

Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check

Top tips:

The –able ending is usually used if a complete root word can be heard before it.

E.g.
adore -> adorable/ adorably

consider -> considerable/ considerably
understand -> understandable/ understandably

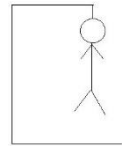
TIP:
If the word ends with –ce or –ge, keep the 'e'

E.g.
change -> changeable (not changable)

The –ible ending is usually used if a complete root word can't be heard before it.

E.g.
possibly
terribly

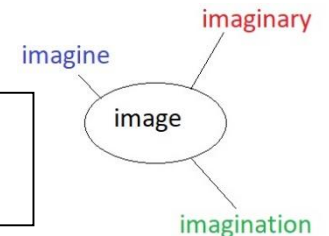
