Suspected case of Covid-19 in school	Pupils, staff, visitors	Spread of disease	 Headteacher/elected staff member in her absence- is alerted that a child in the classroom is unwell. Parents called. Headteacher/ESM collects child and leads them to the outside of the building and re-enters the school by the main entrance. The child is escorted to the meeting room (isolation room) The HT puts on PPE equipment- HT puts up notices to isolate the meeting room area. The medical room toilet is made accessible from the reception area only, for use by the child who is unwell. The HT or ESM only remains with the child until the parent/carer arrives. Isolate child or staff member in meeting room Check temperature and record along with symptoms. Open windows and make patient comfortable-continue to reassure child. Alert parent and send child home with isolation instructions / send staff member home with isolation instructions Identify all others in close contact and prepare contacts list for office to inform parents. Alert Public Health England Deep clean all areas used or visited by child / staff member Alert all staff to hazard and reassure Follow further guidance from RBWM. 	Low
