Try to read a range of authors, genres and text types. Perhaps write some book reviews about the books you read. Present this any way you like.</p> <p>Keep a diary of all the fun learning activities you are doing!</p>
Maths	<p>Maths games. Links to these can be found on the school website on our class page.</p> <p>Times table rock stars – each child has their own login.</p> <p>Help with the cooking by measuring ingredients for your favourite recipe.</p> <p>Set up a shop and play together, adding money and giving change. Topic	<p><u>Project ideas for History (Present this in any way you like!)</u> - Would you like to live in Roman times and why? - If you could make a time machine, what period would you visit and why?</p> <p><u>Project ideas for Geography (Present this in any way you like!)</u> - If you could visit anywhere in the world, where would you go and why? - Choose a country to research.</p>

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<p>RE</p>	<p><u>Project ideas (Present this in any way you like!)</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - What's the best thing about Easter? - What happened in the Easter story? - What is it like to be a Christian in the present day? - Choose a religion to research. Think about their traditions and celebrations.
