
### Staff Summer Fair Stall

## Orders Sent Direct to You (Direct to Parents Service):

Please place your order before the **7th August 2017** for delivery before the new School Year (i.e delivery before Sep 17).

<u>Important Note:</u> You need to allow for our leadtimes when placing your order (and for any subsequent orders you place for different sizes etc). Now is the ideal time to start the process to get everything sorted for September.

## Orders Sent Direct to School (only for parents whose school offer this service):

Please place your order before **30th June 2017** for delivery into school before the end of term - remember to enter your child's name in the "Special Instructions" during checkout. Orders placed after 30/6/17 will be subject to the above "Direct to Parent" cut-off date (7/8/17) and will be delivered to your home address.
